

# Noor Riyadh 2023: Re-discover Wadi Namar this weekend with these 5 fun activities for the whole family

**Riyadh, December 8, 2023** – The world's largest light art festival **Noor Riyadh** has returned for a third time, lighting up the Saudi capital with a series of public artworks until December 16, 2023. The festival brings together more than **120 works** by **100 acclaimed artists**, accompanied by an exciting series of activities, experiences and workshops.

One of the festival's five hubs is the stunning **Wadi Namar**, a popular location known for its striking waterfalls, awe-inspiring cliffs and beautiful nature, which provide a dramatic backdrop for the artworks on show.

As the week draws to a close, we've put together a selection of **5 highlights** to enjoy at Wadi Namar this weekend:

- Explore the Artworks: Observe more than 15 artworks produced by established and
  emerging creatives from Saudi Arabia and the world. From Abdullah Alamoudi's Look
  Up and You'll Find Me to Chris Levine's Molecule of Light to Marinella Senatore's We
  Rise by Lifting Others, the wadi is overflowing with inspiring works.
  Daily until December 16.
- Wild Kingdom: Introduce your children to mural painting with an immersive workshop, where they create a collaborative animal mural using a fun array of tools, including crayons and glow in the dark markers.
   7pm daily until December 16.
- Exploring Art and Nature's Harmonies: Immerse yourself in a journey through Wadi Namar's stunning landscape, adorned with remarkable art installations. Explore the intersection of art, nature, and sensory experiences, through the captivating artworks situated in this picturesque setting.

7pm, 8.25pm and 9.50pm daily until December 16.



- Meditation and Introspection Through Light: Embark on an artistic journey within Wadi Namar which explores diverse artworks, from meditative spaces and serpentinspired iridescence to illuminated doors and powerful stone sculptures.
   7.30pm, 8.40pm and 9.50pm daily until December 16.
- Generative Art: Give your kids a glimpse into the future of generative art with a
  workshop exploring the relationship between art and technology. Participants will
  take photographs using smart devices and then draw out interesting elements using
  tracing paper, highlighters, crayons and graphite. They will then photograph the
  image once again and edit it using software, repeating the process until the original
  image is transformed.
